<i>Types of tanks:</i>	Parallelepipedal tanks, double stainless steel wall, temperature-controlled.
<i>Ageing:</i>	18 months, 40 % new barrels, 30 % one-wine barrels, 10 % amphoras and 20 % vats.
<i>Blend:</i>	79 % merlot, 19 % cabernet franc and 2 % cabernet sauvignon
