



CUVÉE HOMMAGE À ELISABETH BOUCHET

Saint-Emilion Grand Cru

In 2019, only 5 barrels of Cabernet Franc were selected to produce this cuvée.

<i>Origin</i>	Cabernets Francs old vines selection
<i>Geographical Situation</i>	South-facing slope of Saint-Emilion, on the famous «foot of the slope»
<i>Soils</i>	Clay-limestone clay, scree and limestone
<i>Density of plantation</i>	6500 to 8500 vines per hectare depending on the soil characteristics
<i>Grape Composition</i>	100 % Cabernet Franc
<i>Average of the vines</i>	Over 60 years
<i>Pruning</i>	Traditional
<i>Vinifications</i>	In concrete vats
<i>Barrel-filling</i>	As the wine is run off the skins
<i>Ageing</i>	22 months in 80 % new fine grain French oak barrels and 20% in foudres
